What is Storify?


"Storify is a social network service that lets the user create stories or timelines using social media such as Twitter, Facebook and Instagram".

Why use Storify?

- ✓ Storify helps « make sense » of the billions of items that are posted on social media; it lets you choose the most relevant content and turn it into a coherent story.
- ✓ Storify lets you explore, explain and promote any type of story or event: entertainment, news, civil society projects and events ...
- ✓ Storify lets you share content with users even if they don't use a particular platform e.g. share Instagram pictures with people who aren't on Instagram.
- ✓ Storify can help you save time and resources: you gather different content rather than write it all yourself.
- ✓ Storify is free and easy to use and the end result if you use Storify well is informative and visually appealing!


How to get started?

- ✓ Create an account, log in and click on « create a story ».

How to get started?

- ✓ Choose a headline and write a short description of your story.
- ✓ Search for content in the search bar. Drag and drop or click on "add all" in order to add content to the story.
- ✓ Edit the flow of your story by dragging and dropping in order to make sure the different articles appear in the correct order.
- ✓ Add your own explications, transitions and perhaps an introduction and a conclusion in order to make sure your story makes sense.
- ✓ Click on "publish" in order to publish your story.
- ✓ Share your story on Facebook and Twitter. You can also embed your story on your website or blog.
