

**Training Course « EUROMA Cafeteria »**

**Topic:**

The main aim of the training course is to train Roma and non–Roma youth workers, youth leaders together to support rural youth on recognition of their Roma cultural values as traditions and nature. To share youth work methods and tools for motivating and encouraging rural youth to use and renew their Roma traditions and nature for implementing new start ups, initiate small businesses in rural areas in order to fight against unemployment in abandoned villages. The project will be based on the methodology of non–formal education with special focus on experiential learning.
