ONGOING AND UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

EUROPEAN FEST

Throughout May, the city of Strasbourg celebrates Europe and organizes cultural, fun and festive events. Because of its interest for development, European construction, youth projects and interculturality, and to publicize its activities, AMSED has participated to this happy event!



Volunteers from AMSED joined other members of associations, during the Europe Day, May 9th, for an artistic performance entitled “We are all European stars”. They walked together in the center of the city, dressed in blue and holding a big golden veil, to form a human European flag, guided by acoustic sounds. The parade ended by a big circle to show solidarity, diversity and unity. AMSED also organized various workshops to promote its main national and international activities while raising public awareness of environmental protection and MDGs.



The organization proposed a quiz, an In.Ja.Wa.Ra board game and a roundtable, while letting people hear podcasts in which young Europeans have given interesting opinions about their citizenship, the European year for development and the Europe 2020 strategy. Moreover, to promote its textile recycling project in Kabylie (Algeria), AMSED organized a workshop to make children know how to sew stuffed toys with recycled textile.



During European Fest, AMSED also mounted a photo exhibition to present the pictures sent by youngsters from Europe (Spain, Estonia, Portugal, France...) and participated in “photo

rally” to show their vision on development. Thanks to all who shared their photos with us!

And the celebration continues! On 30th and 31st May, AMSED will participate to the Erasmus+ Week-end. Young Europeans will tell their mobility experiences and films about their stories will be screened.

TRAINING COURSES

AMSED will support two of its partners in their projects.

From 1st to 11th August 2015, [Association ACD](#) from France organizes a training course in Aubervilliers, France, about “Artistic practices and dance to improve education for disadvantaged youth”. The aim is to fight against discrimination and attract young people with fewer opportunities into employment.

From 1st to 9th September 2015, the Association of Women, Youth and citizen Initiatives (AFJIC) from France organizes a seminar that will be held in Lvov, Ukraine entitled “Females: fighting exclusion through migration awareness leading empowerment skills” to develop network and raise awareness of violence against women.

GREECE CONTACT-MAKING EVENT

AMSED participates to the multi-measure project of Solidarity Tracks entitled "EVS+SVE: Sustainable



entrepreneurship values through e-learning".

The representative from the association went to the contact making event, held in Lefkada, Greece, from 3rd to 6th May 2015.

Points of discussion included a presentation of AMSED and its activities; proposition of topics for the online courses (e-platform); planning and follow-up of activities; and participants' preparation.

NEPALESE EVENING

Each year, AMSED organizes solidarity workcamps in the city of Bakhapur, in Nepal, where young volunteers restore a school and participate in children education, in partnership with the Nepalese NGO called TOIT for 4 years. Indra Prasad Khatu, the President of the Nepalese association came to Strasbourg; so to show its continuing support for its partner's project, AMSED organized a Nepalese evening on 28th April, and the President of TOIT could meet and inform potential volunteers who are interested in the project about the work camp.

The evening ended with a dance performance and everyone could learn it.
