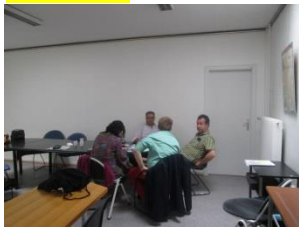

ONGOING AND UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

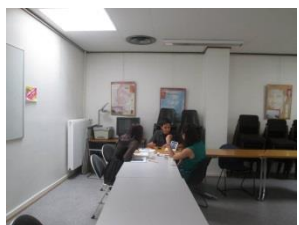
AMSED NETWORK STATUTORY MEETING



From 25th to 28th June 2015,

AMSED and its European partners from Spain,

Norway, Estonia, Greece, and Turkey organized a statutory meeting to talk about their ongoing and upcoming projects. Among the topics: evaluation of network activities, future partnerships, organization of webinars, sending EVS to the construction of ecological houses in

We worked on a strategic partnership aiming at reinforcing digital skills of young workers and their NGOs. We planned also next Meeting for Youth and

Diversity for October 2015 in Turkey which will be hosted by [TREX-EVS](#). That will be a moment to valorize whole year's work and mobility projects.

But there is more to it!

At the end of the day, members of AMSED and European partners shared a friendly moment and we organized a Café for Mobility and Employability in which AMSED volunteers were able to share with the partners the skills gained from international and European mobility.

For this purpose, everyone was asked to describe in one word only what working on an intercultural project had developed in them in terms of knowledge, attitude or aptitude. For some of us, it implies a part of flexibility, adaptability, active listening, and tolerance; for others, passion, dedication, non-verbal understanding, or even patience are essential elements to evolve in an intercultural environment.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Last AMSED General Assembly took place on 27th of June which network partners participated. AMSED 2014 activities, accounts, and projects of the association



were presented. Moreover, volunteers shared their experiences about European and international projects that they took part in.

ALTERNATIBA STRASBOURG

AMSED participated in Alternatiba, an alternative village which was organized



27 -28 June 2015. It is an initiative started up by a group of

associations. On the AMSED stand, you could participate not only in round-table on education and about social start-ups but also in activities for children (sewing stuffed toys with recycled textile). In addition, partners had the opportunity to discover other local and national structures working for environment and sustainability.

TRAINING COURSES

AMSED will support two of its partners in their projects.

From 1st to 11th August 2015, Association ACD from France will organize a training course in Aubervilliers, France, about "Artistic practices and dance to improve education for disadvantaged youth". The aim is to fight against discrimination and attract young people with fewer opportunities into employment.

From 1st to 9th September 2015, the Association of Women, Youth and citizen Initiatives (AFJIC) from France will organize a seminar that will be held in Lvov, Ukraine entitled "Females: fighting against exclusion through migration awareness leading empowerment skills"; the aim of this event is to develop network and raise awareness of violence against women.

MOBILITY-2 FROM GREECE

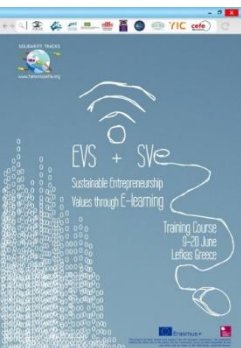
Our partner from Greece, Solidarity Tracks organized the second mobility of the multi-measure project of entitled "EVS+SVE: Sustainable entrepreneurship values through e-learning". This event was held in Lefkada, Greece, from 9th to 20th

June 2015.

Participants from 11 countries worked on online courses (e-platform) in order to benefit new e-learning skills based on informal education and also on modern learning methods.

TC: BLUEPRINT YOUR CAREER, GERMANY

Our partner from Germany, JuBuK organized a training course from 30th June to 6th July 2015 in Kleve, Germany. Entitled "Blueprint your Career", the project aimed at young leaders to develop their competitiveness in labor market and created a learning space where all participants could improve their skills and competences on entrepreneurship.

PRE-DEPARTURE TRAINING

On 6th and 7th June, volunteers who are going to participate in international solidarity work camps in Morocco, Nepal, Burkina Faso, Turkey and Lebanon were trained before their departure. They talked about security, information to know before leaving, and what to expect about the population on site. During this weekend, they got to know more each other, exchanged about their aspirations and about their past experiences. At the end, they summarized what had been said during this training and also talked about the aspects to improve for next time.
