success: 10 young people from 18 to 30 came and showed great interest and motivation. They exchanged a lot about their own experience of hate speech and many of them realised that they have been unintentionally actors of hate speech.

Laughter do have limits as long as it can harm somebody else. We are not aware of how much somebody can suffer on the other side of the screen so we have to be respectful.

These are the conclusions they arrive at the end of the activities. One small step for these young people, one giant leap for the No Hate Speech!
