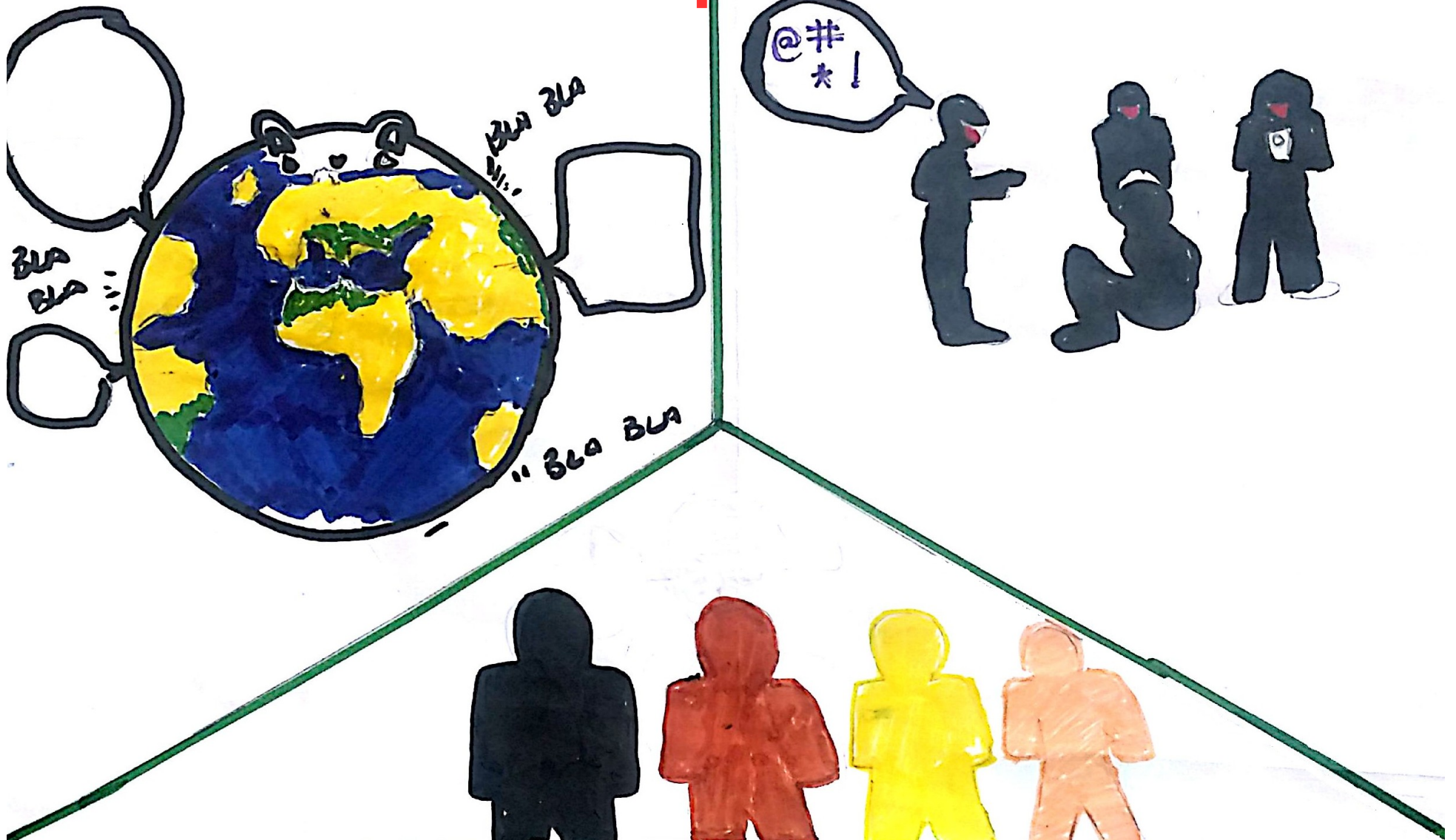


Recommendations elaborated by youngs on the fight against online hatred speeches



AUTHORITIES AND ELECTED

- ➡ Organize exchanges between different local communities in order to sensitize young people to the added values that are the differences between men.



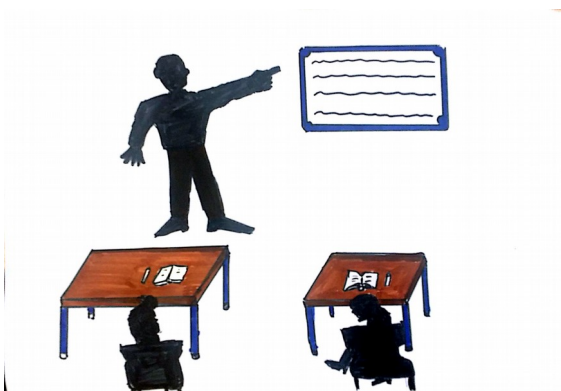
- ➡ Facilitate the access of training courses given by the European Council, make them more frequently and target a largest public.

- ➡ Create platforms or online discussion forums to sensitize people to the fight against harassment in order to help the victims in sharing their testimonies and contact psychologists or instructors.

- ➡ Give more financial help and ways for different social actors in order to allow the awareness of young people and of a general audience via innovative projects.

SCHOOLS, MIDDLE SCHOOLS, HIGH SCHOOLS

- ➡ Use pupils' artistic capacities to create a message or an awareness campaign to fight hatred speeches.



- ➡ Organize intercultural days in schools, so that students can share and exchange around different traditions and cultures.

- ➡ Settle e-citizenship workshops in schools to encourage tolerance, respect and inclusion via simulation games and the testimonies of victims.

- ➡ Establish a greater communication between the local actors (CSC, associations) and the teaching staff through meetings and partnerships.

- ➡ Promote an intensified training course and target educational staff by sensitizing and forming them particularly to the fight against hatred speeches, harassment and cyber harassment.

ORGANIZATIONS

- ➡ Make racism or discrimination victims testify in order to be part of their negative experience and to allow third parties to be open minded and to realize the consequences.



- ➡ Organize festivals to promote the campaign against hatred speeches or lead awareness campaigns against hatred speeches via neighborhood parties.

- ➡ Take advantage of the proximity with hosts in order to resolve some conflicts, realize the problems confronted by young people and raise information.



- ➡ Settle a contest for the realization of a short film on cyber harassment via several neighborhoods CSCs.
