What's the purpose of citizen journalism?

- Reporting about stories and issues that aren't covered by regular journalists
- Provides the community with a view that is different from the one they are usually presented with
- Helps to get people more involved in the issues affecting their lives
- Activism allowing people to express themselves on issues that are of concern to them
- Spreading breaking news and important information faster than regular media
- → enhancing democracy & freedom of expression!

Different types of citizen journalism

• Accidental/opportunistic citizen journalism

• E.g. somemone who happens to be at the scene of 9/11

• Advocacy journalism

• Reporting on an event or a topic with the objective of conveying a specific viewpoint

• Intentional citizen journalism

• E.g. attending a major event in order to be able to report on it
